

## Evergreens Block Pattern

Finished block size - 4" x 4"

## Fabric for 1 block:

Brown
$1-11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " square for trunk
Green $\quad 1-1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle, $5-1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $1 \frac{1}{2}$ "
Light $\quad 2-1 \frac{1}{2} 1^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2}^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles, $4-1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2$ " 2-11/2" x $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares

## Construction for 1 block:

Cut out block pieces and lay them out as shown.


Place shown squares on the corners of the rectangles, right sides together. Draw a diagonal line corner to corner as shown on the wrong side. Sew along the line. Trim away the excess and press.


Sew together two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2$ " light rectangles and one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ dark square as shown to make tree trunk. Press toward dark.


Construct one tree block as shown, press according to arrows.
Block should measure $41 / 2$ " square.
Repeat and make as many tree blocks as desired.
Piece all the tree blocks together as desired; side by side, with an alternate block or with sashing. Add a border if desired. Quilt and enjoy!
