

Pumpkin Patch Quilt

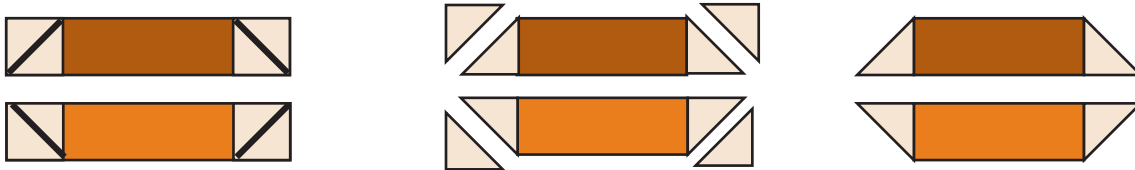
Finished block size - 5" x 5"

Fabric for 1 block:

- Dark 1- 1½" x 1½" square for stem
- Medium 4 - 1½" x 5½" rectangles, 2 or more different prints
- Light 2 - 1½" x 2½" rectangles
4 - 1½" x 1½" squares

Construction for 1 block:

Choose two - 1½" x 5½" rectangles and four - 1½" x 1½" squares. Place one square on one corner of the rectangle, right sides together. Draw a diagonal line corner to corner on the wrong side. Sew along the line. Trim away the excess and press. Repeat on each corner of two rectangles.



Sew together two 1½" x 2½" light rectangles and one 1½" x 1½" dark square as shown to make pumpkin stem. Press toward dark.



Construct one pumpkin block as shown, press according to arrows.

Block should measure 5½" square.

Repeat and make as many pumpkin blocks as desired.

Piece all the pumpkin blocks together as desired; side by side, with an alternate block or with sashing. Add a border if desired. Quilt and enjoy!
