

## Pumpkin Patch Quilt

Finished block size - 5" x 5"

## Fabric for 1 block:

Dark $\quad 1-1 \frac{1}{2} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ square for stem
Medium 4-1 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, 2 or more different prints
Light $\quad 2-1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
4-11/2" x $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares

## Construction for 1 block:

Choose two - $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 5 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles and four - $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Place one square on one corner of the rectangle, right sides together. Draw a diagonal line corner to corner on the wrong side. Sew along the line. Trim away the excess and press. Repeat on each corner of two rectangles.


Sew together two $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ light rectangles and one $1 \frac{1}{2 "} \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " dark square as shown to make pumpkin stem. Press toward dark.


Construct one pumpkin block as shown, press according to arrows.
Block should measure $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.
Repeat and make as many pumpkin blocks as desired.
Piece all the pumpkin blocks together as desired; side by side, with an alternate block or with sashing. Add a border if desired. Quilt and enjoy!
